#### DIGITAL LIBRARY INAUGURATED






reference sources, books and journals, reports, white papers, images, maps, statistics and the like.




#### PROFESSOR RAJ REDDY VISITS CAMPUS

#### GANDHIJI'S BIRTHDAY CELEBRATED




