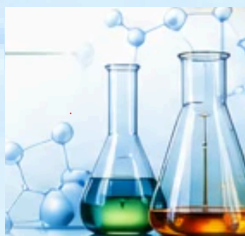
Dr. Lankapalli Bullayya, the then Vice Chancellor of Andhra University.
